We will be reviving our Beautiful Te-Pahu Family Ride from the start of daylight saving so the first one will be on the 14<sup>th</sup> October and since it might be still a bit darkish then so we will make it half an hour earlier than usual at **6pm** to give us time for picnics etc.

It is an easy family-friendly 5k off-road ride suitable for beginners from the Kaniwhaniwha Stream Bridge in Limeworks Loop Road at Te Pahu. The route mostly follows a stream bank on a 4WD track with very gentle rising gradient (it feels flat) up to the picnic area and then a faster ride back to the bridge. This ride can also be extended by the more ambitious riders to include a good fitness building section on some steeper nearby gravel roads, while the families picnic beside the stream. (Weather permitting) **Bring a well-stocked chilly-bin. You'll be hungry afterwards!**
