Thursday night ride Oct 30th- Sainsbury Forest

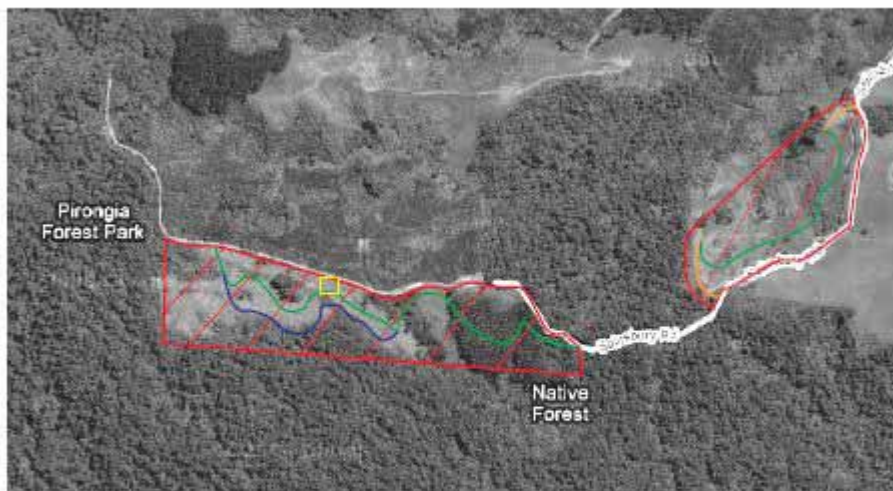
